## **Treasurer's Report:**

- Amber Labrum reported that we have \$13,888.82 in our checking account.

## **December Meeting Minutes:**

- A motion was made to accept the minutes with changes, seconded and approved.

## **Chicago Trip:**

- The directors had a great time at the Chicago workshop. They received the certification credits.
- They learned different techniques to help our band program with at home practicing. They were able to attend various workshops, and see different groups perform.

## **Winter Season:**

- The winter season groups are off to a great start. The Winter Drum line will be competing in the open class the year. They have had a few camps and have learned their first movement.
- We have everything designed in house this year. Jimmy Medonia is doing a great job. Our Drum line now has a facebook page.
- The first drum line show is next weekend. (location TBD)
- The Winter Guard have also had camp and are doing well. They have chosen their music and their first show is February 6th and Mesquite High School.
- Our Guard show will be February 27<sup>th</sup>.

## **Winter Season Budget:**

- Matt Kozacek presented the winter season budget that the Eboard approved. He explained how the booster contributions worked. The boosters will contribute 15% to all groups to take down the fees that the students need to come up with.
- In order for that, booster contributions to happen the Boosters need to raise \$15,000.
- One note about the fees for winter season is that (other than long travel) there is no food provided in the budget. The student will be responsible for providing their own food.
- A trip to Dayton Ohio is in the budget for the Drum line.
- Mr. Kozacek mentioned that he expects our Marching band to increase in size next year.
- A motion was made to accept the winter season budget (attached) without changes. seconded and approved.
