Meeting was called to order by Scott Chan at 6:35pm

Approval of the previous minutes

Band Council report – Sara Kramer and Kyle Headstream reported. They discussed mixing the 4 different band groups for different fund raisers. They discussed that the Penny war fundraiser was starting within the next week. The Jugs are in Mr. K office.

Treasurer's Report – Linda Lacasse. This report is basically the same as last month. Please refer to last months financials from the March meeting, posted on the website.

Old / New Business –

Home Performance on April 11. The winter groups will be performing. This will be a Sendoff for the winter drumline just prior to their Dayton Trip. This will give the Parents the opportunity to see the groups perform so they may take pictures, film or in some cases see the performance for the first time. This has been advertised to our sponsors and local area business as well.

Car Show on April 12 – This is a great fundraiser that has been being planned for some time. Currently there are 10 vendors signed up, 20 cars entered and 14 raffle prizes donated. Generator will be donated for use by one of the band parents.

Firebird Raceway April 25 – 27 – This is the boat races and monster trucks. 2 time shifts Will be available. This is a great fundraiser for a great earning potential for the band. It is crucial that we can get volunteers to earn the total band program money.

Lemonade and Shaves Ice Fundraiser is the same weekend April 25 – 27. This is another Great earning potential for the total band program. We need several volunteers for this event as well.

Yard sale is May 3rd. Currently there has not been a lot of interest in this event. There is a possibility that we will have to cancel due to lack of interest.

Cold Stone Night is May 8th, Pep Band will be performing. The location is Gilbert / Chandler Heights. 20% of everything sold will go to the band programs at Basha High. They will also be selling discount cards at this location being that immediate savings can be used at Cold Stone from our discount cards.

Barnes and NOBELS Bood Fair is on May 10. Jazz will be performing. Jazz will perform at approx 3pm and then move over to Texas Roadhouse around 5 – 6pm.

Band Banquet is May 20. Rigatony's will be the food. The band council will be selling some type of service as a fund raising opportunity. IT will be in the cafeteria at 630pm. There will also be presentation of awards.

Kozaceks Korner / Malleks Minutes – Mr. Kozacek discussed the upcoming Dayton trip. Thursday will be the prelims, Friday is the Semifinals, and Saturday will be the Finals.

He announced that Basha will be getting a new principal. His name is Ken James. He was the principal at Highland High School. He is a strong supporter of the Fine Arts.
